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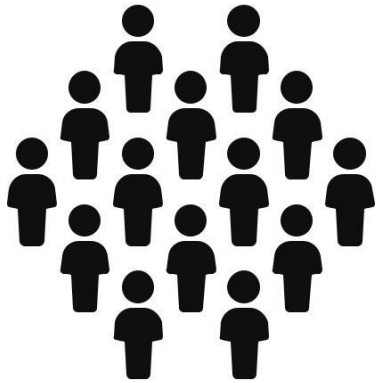

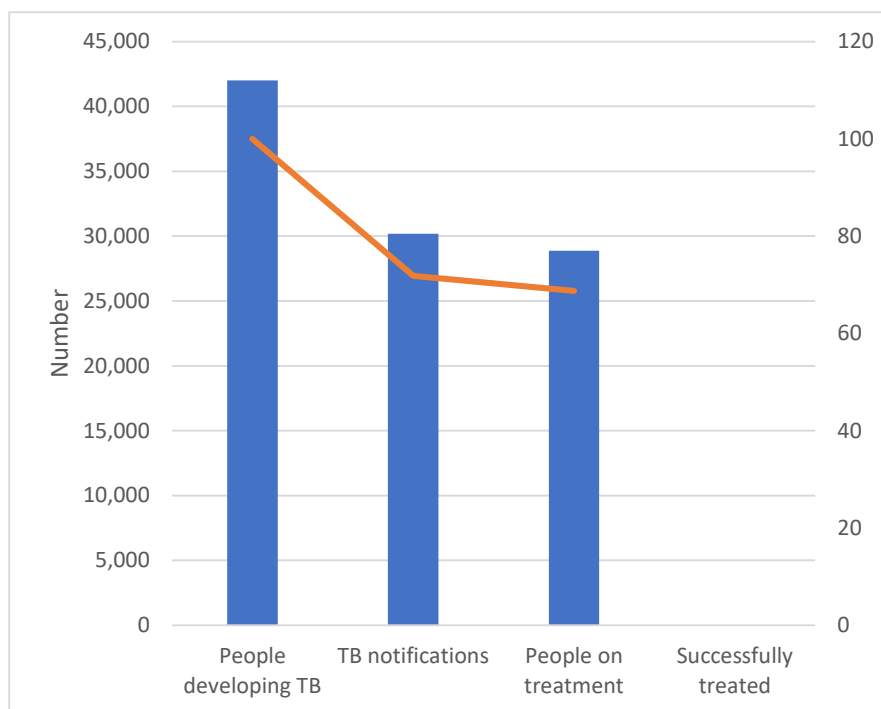

- **13,127** Missing people with TB (**5,351** were children)
- **5,400** people died because of TB
- **478** Laboratory confirmed people with MDR/RR-TB (WHO data, 2021)

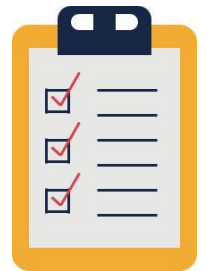
